## Community Projects

### Last Projects for Club Year 2020-2021

Near the end of the club year, the Community Service committee had some monies left unallocated. The club members expressed enthusiasm for the presentation Jessica Barajas made about our history with the Girls Club of San Diego and its merger with the Boys and Girls Club, so we approached Jessica for a proposal for the girls of her club. Following is Jessica's response. We believe our donation will be very well spent:

The money donated will be going to the William J. Oakes branch, the oldest of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater San Diego's 20 sites that serves the Logan Heights community and is just a few blocks away from the old Girl's Club location. The money will be used to purchase a Cricut die cut machine as well as an iPad to use with the machine. The machine will be used to kick off the new Crafting Program for teen girls at the club house. With this machine, the girls will be able to create custom logos, shirts, mugs, cards, etc. They will then in turn sell these items to people in order to gather enough money to help those in need during the holidays. The girls will be able to shop for those in need of sweaters this winter. This program can and will become bigger with the help of SISD. There will be a big push for volunteers throughout this process, but it will be extremely rewarding.

Jessica, be sure to let us know exactly what the girls make at Holiday time so we can buy some, too.



Last Saturday, July 17<sup>th</sup>, Kathy Biewenga, Susie Hartmann, Grace Meyers and her daughter, Marsha gathered at Margie McNeil's house to sort school supplies for ***Girls Rising***. The paper, pencils, binders, etc. were put in gift bags for 18 girls and 5 backpacks were added for those not in the program last year. Their numbers are down now due

to Covid 19. There will be a picnic at the beach, which we sponsor, to distribute the items in August. It will be fun.
